POLICIES AND PROCEDURES ON THE PAYMENT AND

VALIDATION OF EXAMINATION FEES FOR THE 2018 SPECIAL

PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE EXAMINATION (SPLE)

Pursuant to the Commission's Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Land Bank of the Philippines (Landbank) dated 16 April 2018, the PRC has availed of Landbank's e-payment system (Link.BizPortal) which will accept examination fees from OFWs who will take the 2018 SPLE. Thus:

- Online payment will be available to Landbank and BancNet Member-Banks ATM and Debit Cardholders and Globe GCash.
- Payments will be automatically debited from the applicant's account in real time manner and shall be consequently credited to the account of National Treasury-PRC.
- The Landbank's Link. BizPortal requires the payment in Philippine Peso per PRC Resolution No. 1102 Series of 2018 re: Prescribing the Examination Fees for the 2018 Special Professional Licensure Examination (SPLE) as follows:

Requiring Baccalaureate Degree	Php 2,200
Requiring Non-Baccalaureate Degree	Php 1,700
For Removal Examination	Php 1,400

 Transaction fees shall be charged/collected by Landbank and BancNet Member-Banks and Globe GCash as follows:

Payment Source/Option	Transaction Fee	Remarks	
Landbank ATM Cards/ Debit Cards	Php 10.00	Regardless of amount of transaction	
BancNet Member-Bank's ATM/Debit Cards	Php 20.00	Regardless of amount of transaction (Please see attached list of participating banks)	
Globe GCash	Php 20.00 Php 30.00	For transactions upto Php 999 For Transactions Php 1000 and above	

 The applicant shall present the "Payment Confirmation Receipt" to the official delegates of PRC as proof of payment, in their respective venue/place of examination.
